
Downloading from the Media Library (https://stream.uhi.ac.uk)

In some instances, videos can be downloaded from the Media Library by logging in to view the video. Scroll down the page until you see the 'Download' icon.



Right-click the icon and select 'Save as ...' (this may be slightly different depending on the browser being used).

The downloaded file should be an MP4 file but may not be as high quality as the original file which had previously been uploaded. The Terms and Conditions of this video streaming service does recommend that the original file be retained as the video is encoded for streaming purposes.

If the downloaded file is a text file, it is likely that the security settings on the video's category do not permit download of the file.

The terms and conditions of the service are given below for reference:

Please note that the original uploaded file is not retained by this system and as the content owner we expect you to maintain an offline copy of the material you upload into this service.
